"Law" is a selective discipline, the study of which is an important component of modern economic education of students, which is especially important in connection with the development of European integration processes, the formation and approximation of national legislation to global legal values. The study of this discipline allows us to explore the basics of the theory of state and law, the basics of civil, family, labor, administrative and criminal law, including economic aspects of legal regulation of social relations, the only legal basis of which is property rights.

As an object of state and legal action, the economy is a complex phenomenon, one of the important basic industries of which is railway transport. The railways of Ukraine contribute to the normal functioning of all branches of economic and other activities, social and economic development of the state and the entry of the transport complex of Ukraine into the European and world transport system. Railway transport and its warehouse, which includes enterprises, railway transport institutions that carry passengers, cargo, rolling stock, perform a large amount of work. The activity of railway transport is based on legal, economic, organizational and social principles defined by laws, codes, statutes, regulations and other state and international regulations, which are mandatory for all legal entities and individuals and relate to the relationship of the railway with the clientele. At the same time, the discipline "Law" covers the study of general theoretical provisions and general rules of Ukrainian legislation, as well as the study of special theoretical provisions and transport legislation, the rules of which regulate, reveal the essence and content of railway transport, its features and differences and ways to improve met the modern requirements and challenges of society for its sustainable development.

The course aims to form and develop the following student competencies:

- 1. Knowledge of methods of critical analysis, synthesis and evaluation of modern scientific achievements, as well as methods of generating new ideas in solving research and practical problems of legal regulation of professional social relations.
- 2. Ability to perform critical and systematic analysis of various legal phenomena, legal facts, to interpret and apply knowledge in practical situations relating to the legal regulation of various social relations.
- 3. Ability to search, collect, analyze, systematize and summarize the provisions of legal science and practice using electronic services, platforms and databases.
- 4. Ability to use legal and economic terminology in the process of professional activity on the legal regulation of public relations.

- 5. Ability to analyze problems in the field of legal regulation of public relations, including professional, competently and accurately form and express their legal positions on these problems, to offer reasonable ways to solve them, to provide explanations, advice on these issues.
- 6. Ability to model and predict legal situations in professional activities by applying the acquired knowledge in the field of economics
- 7. Knowledge of the legal basis of civil, family, labor, administrative and criminal law .. Knowledge of the legal regulation of relations in railway transport
- 8. Ability to apply the acquired legal knowledge on the legal regulation of public relations and predict typical legal situations and avoid typical situational legal errors in solving professional problems.
- 9. Identify problems in the legal regulation of economic and other activities and suggest ways to solve them using existing theoretical and applied knowledge.
- 10. Analyze legal problems and solve practical problems based on the application of specific legal norms on the legal regulation of public relations, including professional, to form legal positions and carry out legal actions in strict accordance with the law.

As a result of mastering the discipline, the applicant must demonstrate the following learning outcomes:

- 1. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of methods of critical analysis, synthesis and evaluation of modern scientific achievements, as well as methods of generating new ideas in solving research and practical problems on legal issues
- 2. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the peculiarities of the legal regulation of public relations in railway transport in accordance with the level supported by advanced textbooks and includes certain aspects related to the most advanced knowledge.
- 3. Have the skills of critical and systematic analysis of legal phenomena, legal facts, legal norms and relevant legal relations in the fields of law.
- 4. Know and explain the nature and content of the institutions of civil, family, labor, administrative and criminal law, features of their implementation
- 5. Correctly interpret and apply the rules. Solve practical problems and carry out legal actions in strict accordance with the law.
 - 6. Use knowledge and practical skills in solving legal problems in professional activities.
- 7. Search and logical, critical and systematic analysis of legal documents on legal issues, using information technology and databases, electronic services.
- 8. Justify their point of view when discussing issues of discussion, provide explanations, use the necessary material to prove and defend their position; solve problems and problems on economic and legal issues.
- 9. Predict typical legal situations and avoid typical situational legal errors in the regulation of professional activities.
- 10. To use legal terminology in the process of professional activity in the field of legal regulation of public relations to operate with legal concepts and categories of the specified sphere.

WHY SHOULD YOU TAKE THIS COURSE?

As an object of state and legal action, the economy is a complex phenomenon, as a system of relations for the production, distribution, exchange and consumption of material goods. The legal form is most consistent with the nature of economic relations, their market nature. The formation of economic relations has given rise to various institutional forms of their consolidation, stabilization, development and protection. Law and economics are closely interrelated, because the nature and content of law are directly dependent on economic relations, property relations. Ukraine, as a modern state, actively uses the law to act on the economy through the regulation of property, labor relations, commodity relations, financial, tax, customs, etc., namely the adoption of relevant legislation. Thus, the rules of law reflect economic relations, economic interests of owners and other social groups of the population of Ukraine. Law not only affects the economy, it is an immanent part of it.

Thus, law can be interesting as a way of self-regulation of the economy, as legal freedom and security, which allow businesses to hear market signals and take them into account, to regulate the economic aspects of entrepreneurship by law and through law.

Attending lectures:

Points for this component are not accrued at all, if the student did not attend more than 50% of lectures in the module without good reason. 0.7 points are awarded for attending each lecture. The maximum amount is 10 points.

Degree of involvement:

The purpose of participating in the course is to engage you in a discussion, expand your learning opportunities for yourself and your classmates, and give you another way to test your knowledge of the application of legal norms. Participation will be evaluated based on the number and accuracy of your answers. Issues, although encouraged, are not evaluated in this block. We strive to provide all students with equal and fair opportunities to increase their own involvement. The maximum amount is 10 points.

Seminars:

Evaluated by visits (up to 5 points); degree of activity: performance of abstract work (up to 10 points), performance of test tasks, incidents (up to 30 points). The maximum amount is 35 points.

Modular testing:

Evaluated by the correct answers to the test modular questions (10 questions in the test, each correct answer is evaluated in 4 points). The maximum number is 40 points per module.

Test:

The student receives a credit for the results of the modular 1st and 2nd control by accumulating points. The maximum number of points that a student can receive is 100 (up to 60 points of current control and up to 40 points of testing). The arithmetic mean of the sum of modular grades is the credit score. If the student does not agree with the proposed scores, he can increase them on the test, answering questions from the teacher (Appendix 1).

The concept and characteristics of the rule of law (fundamental), the basic provisions of law, its importance in society, the basic provisions of the Constitution of Ukraine - as the Basic Law of Ukraine, the principles of separation of powers in Ukraine (introductory), the legal basis of public authorities, their competence introductory), rights, freedoms and responsibilities of man and citizen (applied), the main provisions of the Constitution of Ukraine, the Laws of Ukraine "On Transport", "On Railway Transport", and other legislative acts on the duty of citizens, government agencies, officials on the functioning of railway transport (introductory-oriented), legal bases of disciplinary, administrative, material, civil and criminal liability (introductory-oriented), ways to strengthen the legality and prevention of offenses in railway transport of Ukraine (applied, creative), legal regulation labor relations on the railway transport of Ukraine (introductory).

Also masters the skills to correctly apply the provisions of the laws of Ukraine on transport and other legal acts in their own practice (reproductive), to organize legal training and legal education of subordinates (applied, creative), legal means to strengthen discipline and law and order and prevent offenses (reproductive).
