REQUIREMENTS FOR PREPARATION OF REPORT MATERIALS:

- Abstracts of the report are printed on sheets of A4 format with margins of 2 cm on each side. Font Times New Roman, point 14, interval 1.5. Paragraph prominence 1, 25. Alignment widthwise
- Materials are accepted exclusively in the electronic version in the format of MS WORD files (sent by e-mail of the conference).
- The number of co-authors is no more than four.
- The volume of theses is 2-3 pages. Each additional page of theses exceeding the specified volume is paid for additionally.

Location on the page:

Surname, initials of the author (bold font) with an indication of degree and title should be printed in the upper right corner in italics; from the next line, the name of the institution and the city of its location are printed in the center;

from the next line – the name of theses in the middle of the line in capital letters (bold font);

below - the text of theses is printed;

the list of used literature, prepared according to DSTU 8302:2015
